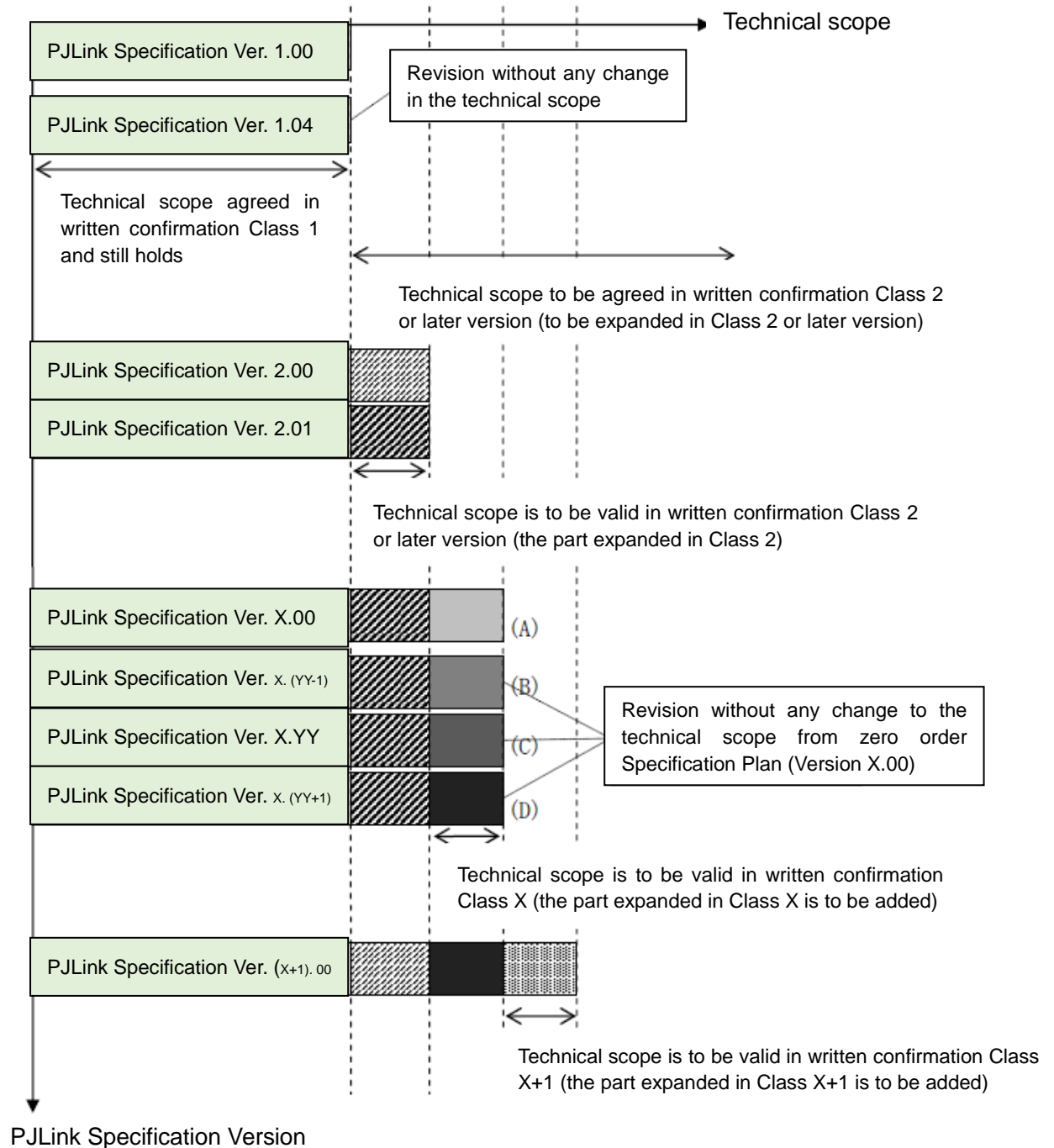


## “Relationship between Agreement and Confirmation”

Relationship between PJLink and Written Confirmation, illustrated with examples.



- (1) Written Confirmation requested by the PJLink Working Group when becoming a member company shall be based on the latest PJLink Specification Version X.YY. This latest PJLink Specification Version X.YY technically includes item (A) in the initial Specification Version X.00 as well as item (C) in following revised versions. However, these items are included in the technical scope of the zero order Specification Plan of the initial Specification Version X.00.
- (2) The Written Confirmation set forth in (1) above, as long as it is included in the technical scope in the zero order Specification Plan of the initial Specification Version X.00, shall be valid for (i) the technologies (technical content A) defined in the initial Specification Version X.00 set up based on the zero order Specification Plan, as well as for (ii) the technologies (technical content A and B) defined in previously revised Specification Version X.(YY-1) – the upgraded Version of the initial Specification Version X.00.
- (3) Furthermore, the Written Confirmation set forth in (1) above, as long as it is included in the technical scope of the zero order Specification Plan of the initial Specification Version X.00, shall be valid for the items (A and D) to be defined in the future revised Specification Version X.(YY+1). Therefore, each member company shall not be requested to submit a new Written Confirmation for the technology to be defined in the future revised Specification Version X.(YY+1) as long as they are included in the technical scope in said zero order Specification Version Plan.  
Whether they are included in the technical scope of the zero order Specification Plan will be determined by the PJLink Working Group through an examination.
- (4) Where a new technical item which is not included in the technical scope of said zero order Specification Plan is included in the upgraded revision of the initial Specification Version X.00, said upgraded revision shall be set up as a new Specification Version (X+1). 00. In this case, the PJLink Working Group shall request each member company to submit a new Written Confirmation based on the zero order Specification Plan of Specification Version (X+1).00 which includes said new technical item.

In addition, where the zero order Specification Plan of the new Specification Version (X+1).00 includes part or all of the technologies defined in the zero order Specification of the initial Specification Version X.00, regarding any overlapping part, the Written Confirmation submitted based on the zero order Specification Plan of the initial Specification Version X.00 shall be valid for technologies to be defined based on the zero order Specification Plan of the new Specification Version (X+1).00.
